The Clay Centre is a new teaching venue in Carrboro, NC, specializing in pottery and art classes for teens and adults. We have well-equipped, professional studios with an emphasis on exchange among artists, collaboration, and group creative energy. We encourage students of all levels to expand their creative activities within a supportive community of artists and teachers. Our classes range from teaching basic skills to providing technical information for more advanced clay artists.

Registration takes place at **The Clay Centre** in person or by mail. Please come to **The Clay Centre** during business hours (M-F, 10-4) or mail in your registration form. Forms may be downloaded from our website, www.claycentre.com. Please include payment with your registration form (make checks payable to **Classes at the Clay Centre**).

Withdrawal or refunds: No refunds will be given after the first class has met. Before classes have met, if a student withdraws following registration, a \$20 administrative fee will be retained. If a class is not held as scheduled, students will receive a full refund.

Open Studios will be held as announced. Students currently enrolled in classes may come to practice their skills. No fee will be charged for open studios. There will be a charge for firing pieces from additional clay.

Advanced Wheel ~

This class will focus on form, making pots that are based on good design and functional qualities. Susan will give weekly demonstrations to help develop throwing skills and the concepts of form. *Students must be able to center clay competently for this class. This class will last 7 weeks.*

The Potter's Wheel, Special Projects ~

This class is for students who are able to center 4-6 pounds of clay and have experience on the potter's wheel. Students will receive individual attention, with a focus on form and technique. *For returning students, or new students with the permission of the instructor. This class will last 7 weeks.*

Thursday Daytime Wheel~

Students will learn to center and throw cylinders and related forms—tumblers, bowls, and mugs. Pots will be glazed and fired to cone 6. *This class is for beginning or continuing students who have little experience on the wheel. This class will last 7 weeks.*

Students will learn basic throwing skills including centering, as well as pulling handles and trimming. Shapes will include cylinders, bowls, and small vases, with a focus on altering forms after throwing. Pots will be glazed with cone 6 stoneware glazes. *All skill levels welcome! This class will last 7 weeks.*
